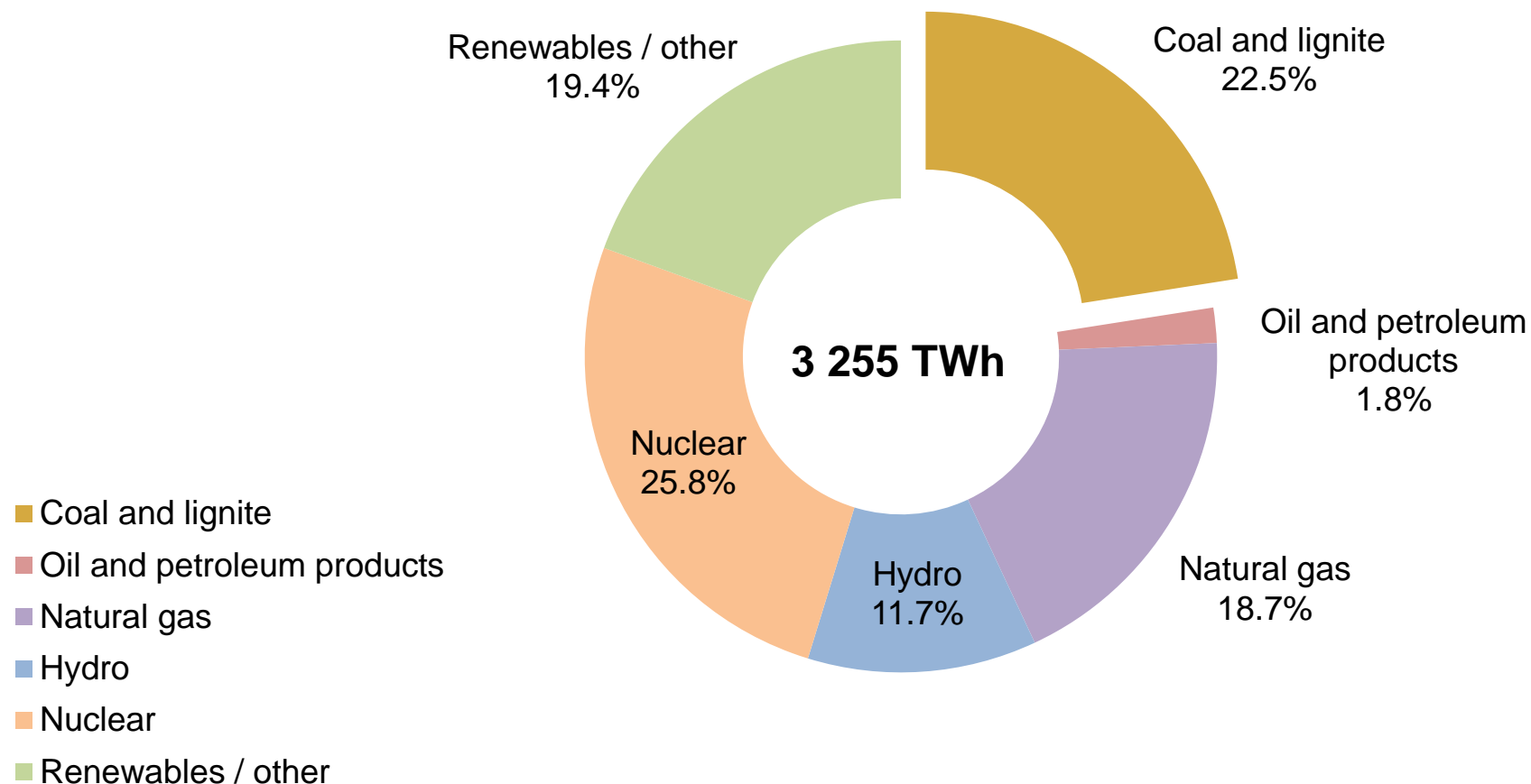

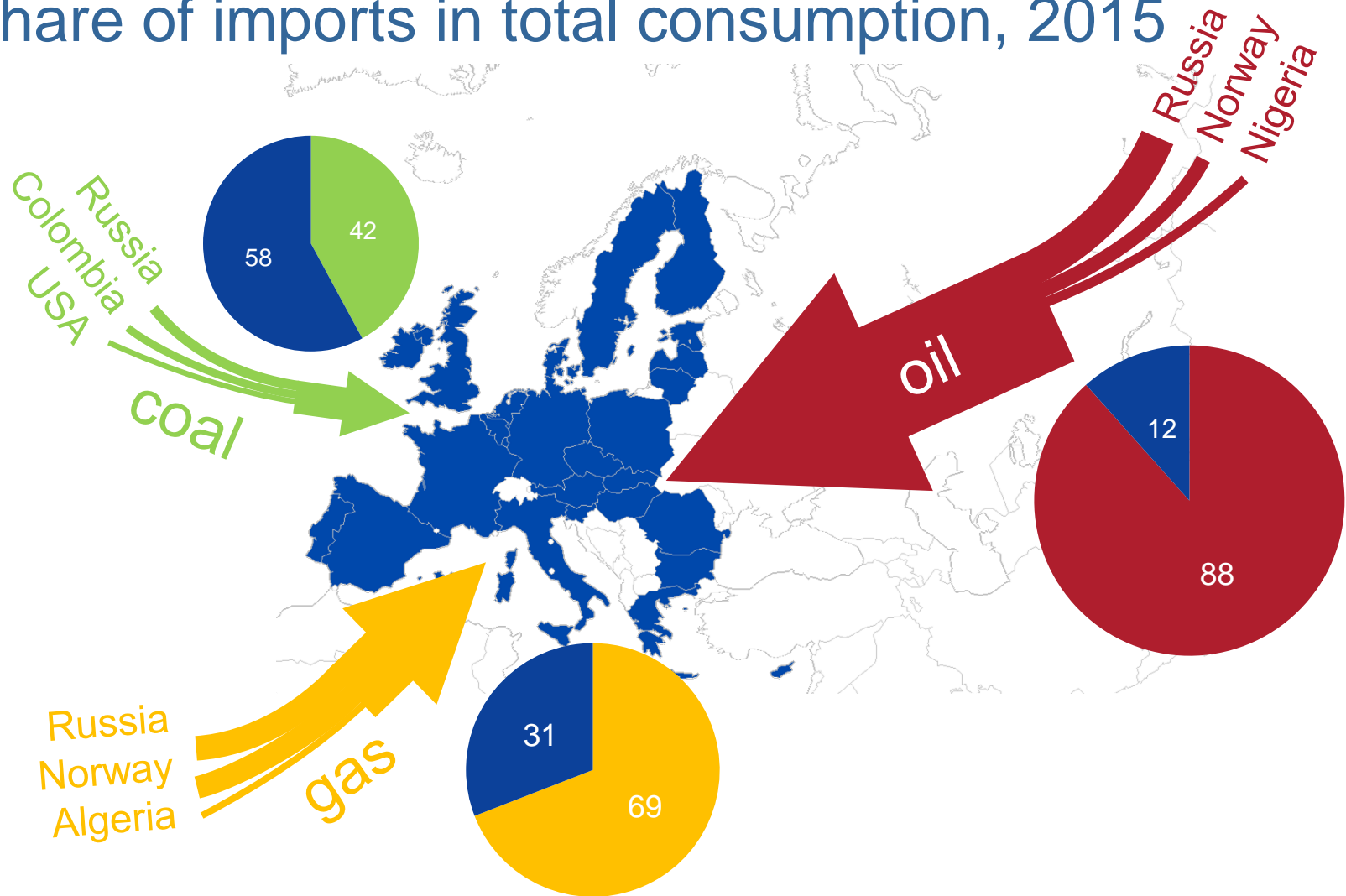
Energy mix for EU28 electricity generation, 2016

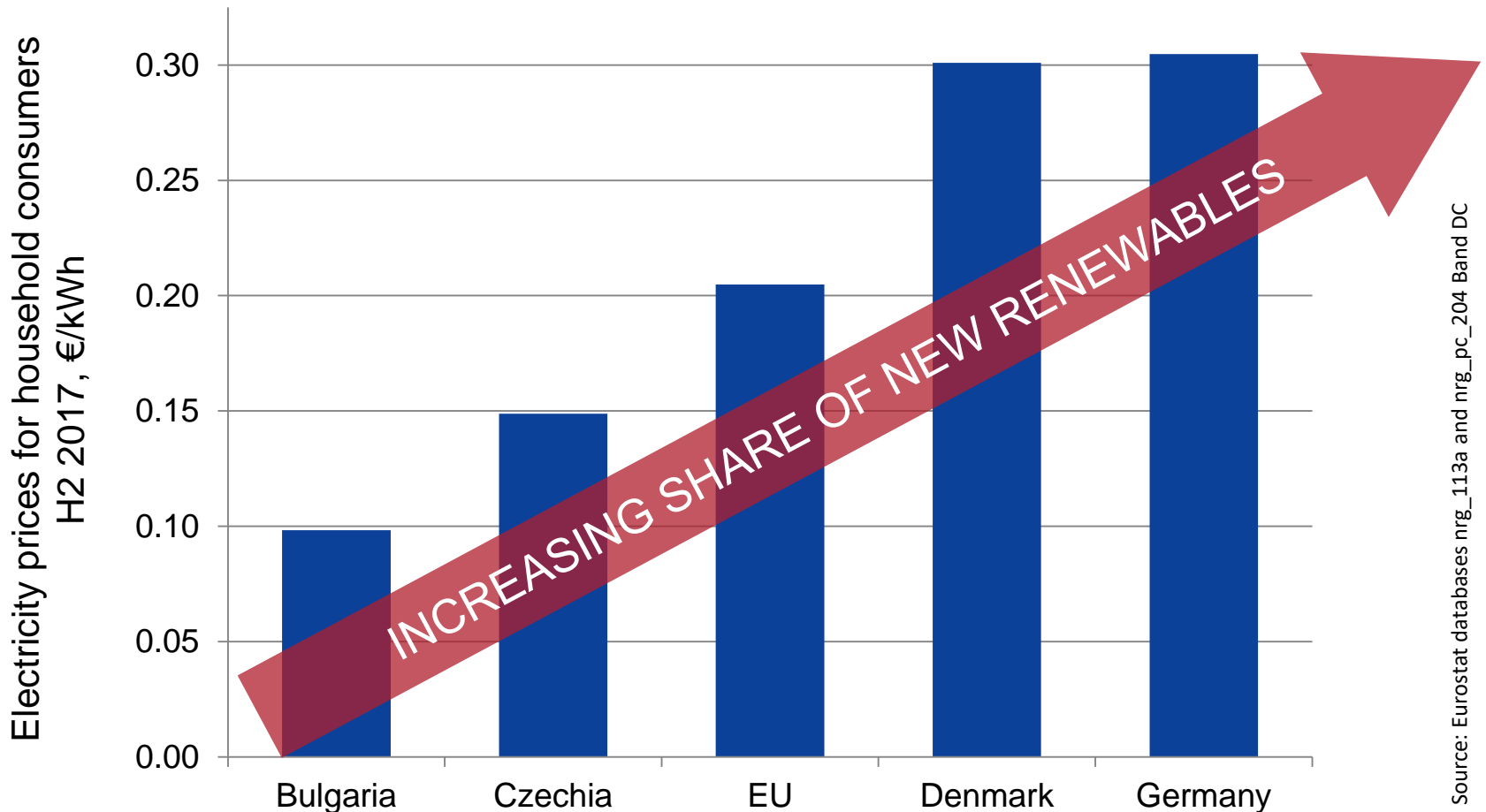
Around the world, 38.2% of electricity supply is generated from coal.

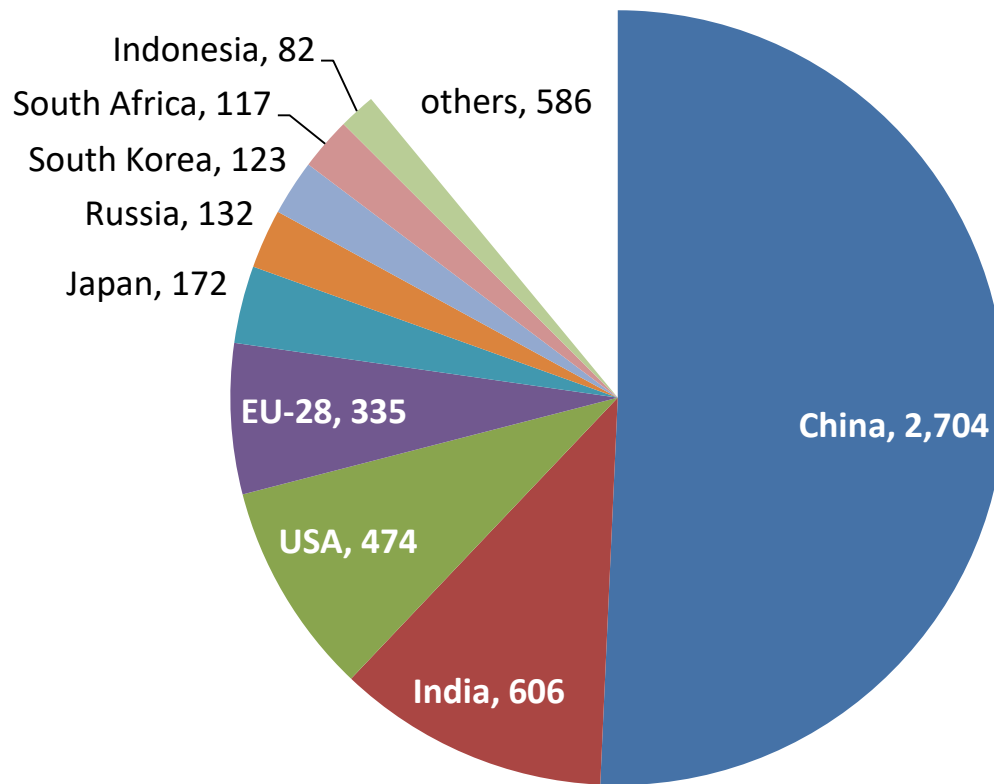
